Shop at Sainsbury's and SUPPORT NVK.

The salient points of the scheme are:

- 1. Scheme is open to all members, friends, families can join the scheme. **So inform everyone you know about this scheme.**
- 2. One has to register and apply for a card.
- 3. Once card comes then you put some on the card by debit card using the computer. Minimum amount is £50.00 and maximum is £1000.00. (**YOU MUST LOOK after the card...if it is lost others can use it...**though you can cancel the card if this happens)
- 4. Every time one goes to Sainsbury's to shop they pay with that card and the amount will be taken from the card.
- 5. Card must be kept safe as if it is lost then anyone can use it.
- 6. If you are not using the computer then ask your children or friends to help you OR ask NVK committee members to help you.
