adherent of **Mahatma Gandhi** during the non-violent Indian Independence movement. He was highly respected for his leadership in uniting the 552 princely states of India to form the single large Union of India. This is the world's tallest statue with a height of 182 meters tall and located on a river island facing the **Sardar Sarovar** Dam on **river Narmada** 100km Southeast of **Vadodra.** Everyone enjoyed this interesting talk and some were mesmerised to hear about this fascinating Historical event.
