PROGRAMMES IN August 2023:

03/08: Morning yoga was conducted by Nootanben Laxman & Manishaben. After lunch we had a Quiz conducted by Dr. Kapashi. All the ladies were seen tying the 'rakhi' on the hands of gents and then offering the sweets to each other.

At 11.35am the Music Band on the stage at far end of the Hall started with the Navkar Mantra Dhun and then the Gayatri Mantra. After the auspicious start of favourite songs.
