<u>Annual General Meetíng 27th March 2014.</u>

As per normal practice we had special lunch menu for the AGM and included shikhand with fruit. Over 200 members were present. The meeting started soon after 2.00 p.m. Meeting started with prayers followed by one minute silence in memory of those who departed during the year. Minutes of the last AGM were read and approved.

The president gave his report in English and later briefly in Gujarati. The salient points were :

- NVK is open to all irrespective of caste, creed or race.
- We were invited by NCVA and Mahavir Foundation and he thanked them for the same.
- Gujarat Samachar under its Samwad program honoured our secretary Jayant Doshi which was an honour for NVK as such.
- Without the dedication of volunteers all this work was not possible and he thanked them all.
- He said that secretary's work involved a lot more than what we see here. He has to negotiate, get best prices, arrange coaches for day trips, plan trips, arrange programs, get speakers etc.

The secretary in his report talked about the various programs conducted through the year. We had 3 long trips, a few day trips, two music programs, several health programs, participation in Sewa Day and lots and lots of in-house entertainment with 3 week "NVK Has Talent" as the high point of these. He thanked Manisha our yoga teacher, staff of Sattavis Patidar Centre, Meera Catering, all the volunteers and the committee members. The secretary also informed that an agreement with Cineworld had been finalised and our members can watch Bollywood movie for $\pounds 3.00$.

The treasurer presented the accounts for the year which showed a surplus of £8187.00 mainly due to the generosity of members who donated on happy occasions and was topped by a donation of £1000.00 from one of the members. Besides donations, and sponsored lunches, we also had refund on Gift Aid which bolstered the funds. Dipak Shah, our auditor was thanked for his services. Dipak Shah has agreed to continue as our auditor and we thank him for the same.

In any other business it was suggested that with so much funds we should take all members on a free showing of Bollywood Movie.
