Get your NHS COVID Pass letter

Just sending again the reminder to get your COVID PASS. This was sent by Prafulbhai on 27th June.

If you haven't done it, please do it now. Our President Vinodbhai, Prafulbhai, Punambhai and Mahendrabhai has already got their Covid Pass. It will be very useful for you in future to travel abroad. Just click on the Link bellow which will take you to the form. It will guide you how to feel the form.

You can ask your children to fill it for you. Many of our members have applied and have got their Covid Passes.

Before you start

They will ask you some questions, so they can find your vaccination record.

If they can find your vaccination record, they will send you a letter to the address you have registered with your GP surgery. You should get this letter within 5 working days

Non-Digital users

There is an alternative to using a mobile device or computer to access your COVID Pass status and this is via the 119 telephone service, where you can call to request a letter. Welsh citizens can also use this non-digital route to receive a letter - initially from a local service (300) and in the coming weeks, via the same 119 service as English citizens.
